

Resolution No. 20-04

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARION, KANSAS DECLARING AN END TO A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY; RECINDING THE TEMPORARILY EXPANDING THE AUTHORITY OF THE MAYOR AND/OR CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; REGARDING THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19, a respiratory disease that spreads easily from person to person and may result in serious illness or death has been confirmed in Kansas; and

**WHEREAS**, a State of Disaster Emergency was proclaimed by the Governor for the State of Kansas in its entirety on March 12, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, The Governor of the State of Kansas has rescinded Executive Orders 20-16, 20-24, and 20-25 by issuance of Executive Order 20-29 dated April 30; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MARION:**

**Section 1.** A Local State of Emergency Declaration has ended on May 1, 2020.

**Section 2.** The temporary authority granted the Mayor and/or City Administrator is hereby revoked, with regard to the authority to make all decisions in regard to personnel and City operations without the need to obtain Council approval for said action.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption

**ADOPTED** this 4<sup>th</sup> day of May 2020 and **SIGNED** by the Mayor.
