- 1<sup>st</sup> Utility Bills are mailed  
15<sup>th</sup> Payment is due  
16<sup>th</sup> 10% Penalty is assessed and  
FINAL NOTICES are mailed  
24<sup>th</sup> Service is disconnected  
without further notice

NOTE: Bills run a month behind  
therefore new customers may not  
receive their 1<sup>st</sup> bill for a month after  
service is established.
