<u>Call to Order:</u> Mayfield called the meeting to order at 6:05pm.

Consideration of Donation Request for 140 N. Cedar: Holter reported that the Unruh's property owners of 140 N Cedar have completed the application to donate the property to the land bank. Holter also reported the structure is still sound but there are three intrusions on the roof that would need repaired. Holter advised that if this property was accepted into the land bank it becomes part of the inventory and would seek proposals to renovate the property. Holter advised that if not accepted into the land bank then the condemnation process would proceed. Herbel moved to accept the donation of this house into the land bank; Kline seconded; motion carried 5-0.

<u>Annual Report Submission:</u> Holter presented the year end 2020 annual report with no inventory, expenditures of \$44.00 for publication costs and generated \$1,000.00 in revenue. Costello moved to approve the annual report; Gray seconded; motion carried 5-0.
