

ORDINANCE NO. 1485

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-102 OF THE MARION CITY CODE PERTAINING TO THE SALE OF CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES WITHIN A SPECIFIED DISTANCE OF THE MAIN ENTRANCE TO ANY CHURCH, SCHOOL, LIBRARY, OR HOSPITAL.

WHEREAS, The Elected Governing Body of the City of Marion, Kansas have determined the amendment of this requirement to align with K.S.A. 41-710 is beneficial and advisable for the citizens, employees, elected officials and participants in the administration of the local governmental process.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MARION, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: Chapter III Article 1 General Provisions, Section 3-102 (c) of the Marion City Code shall be amended to read as follows:


(c) No alcoholic liquor shall be sold or served and no place of business for the sale of cereal malt beverage for consumption on the premises shall be located in any building within 200 feet of the main entrance to any church, school, library, or hospital. Said distance to be measured from the nearest portion of the licensed building to the main entrance of the protected property.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and publication of a summary hereof certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney in the Official Newspaper of the City.
